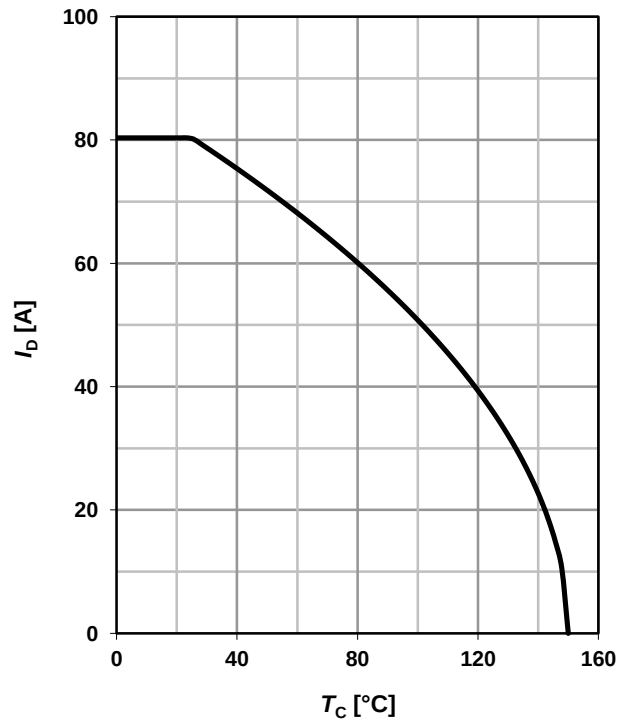

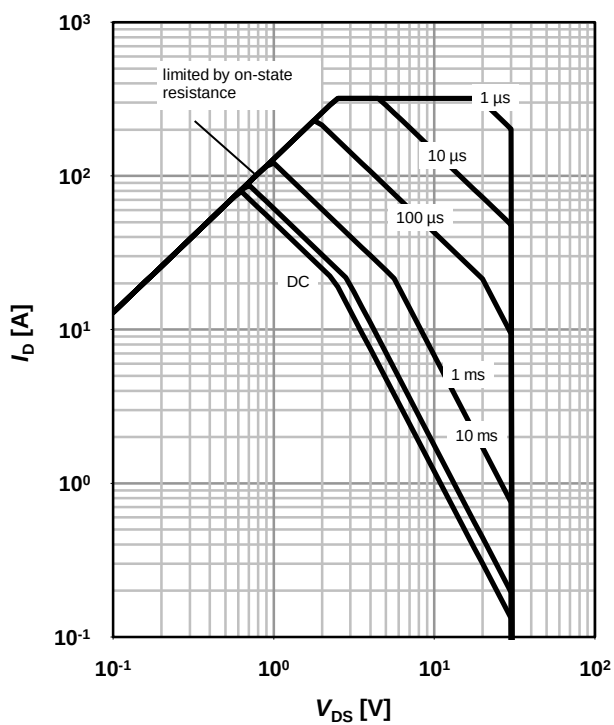

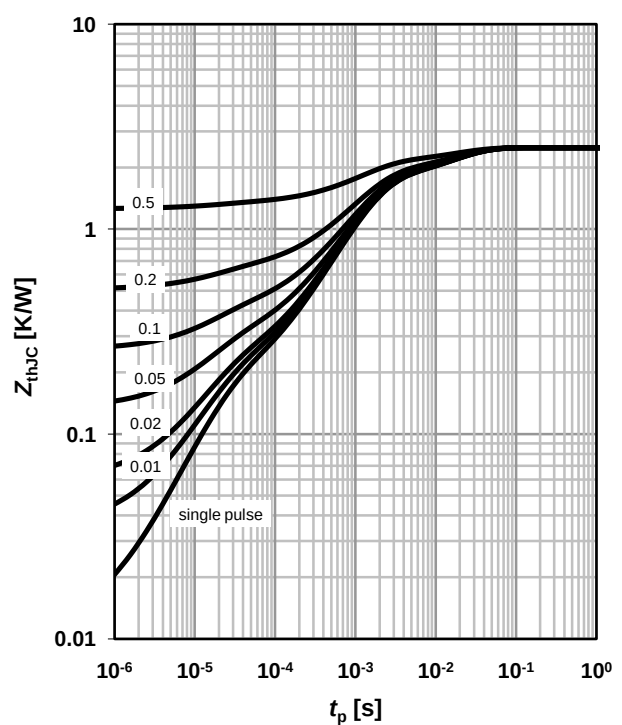

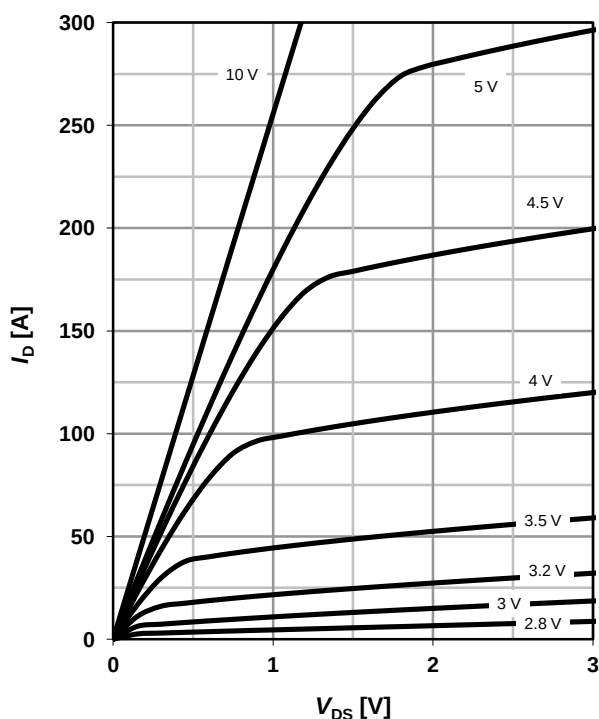

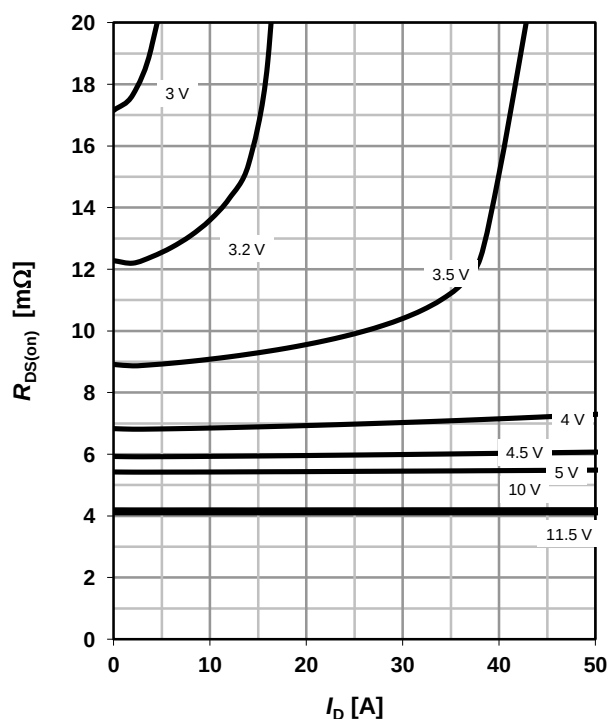

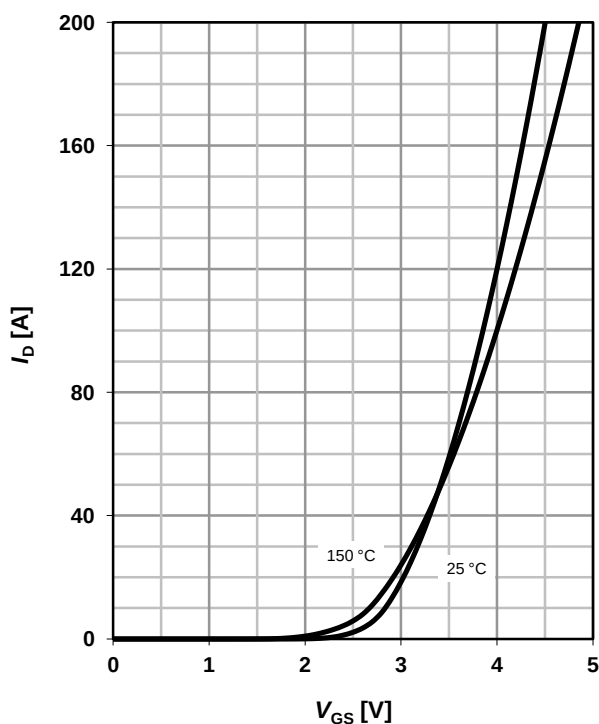

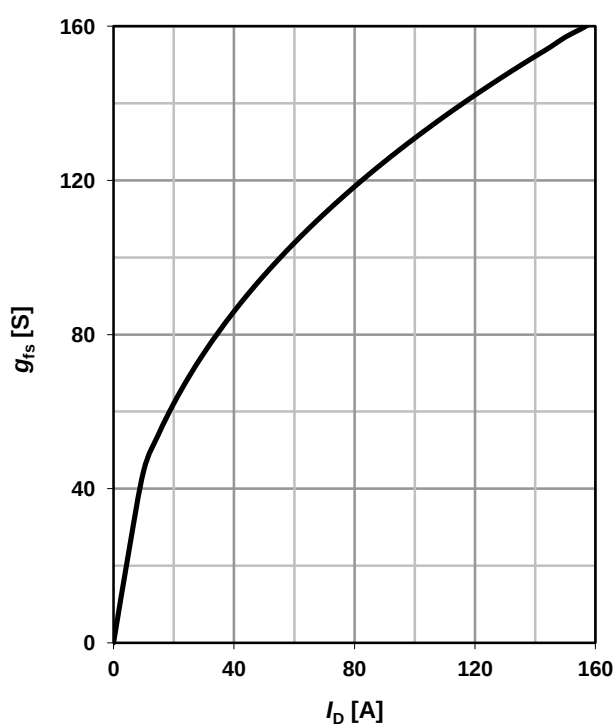

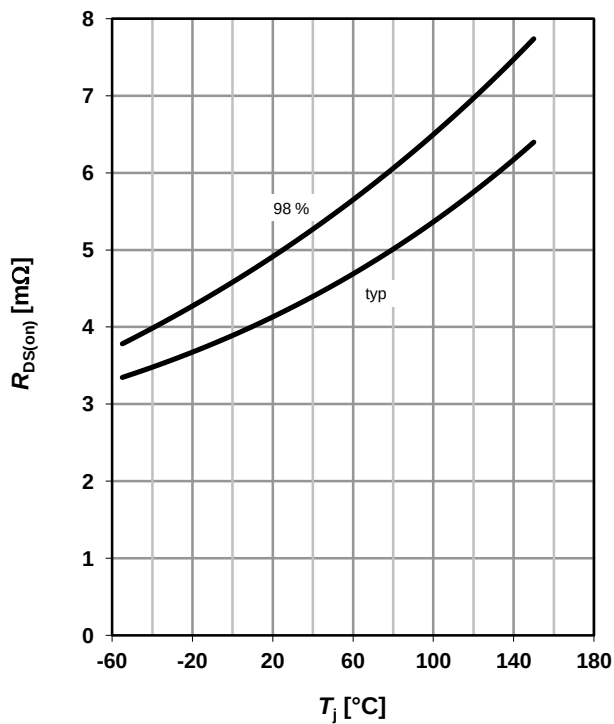

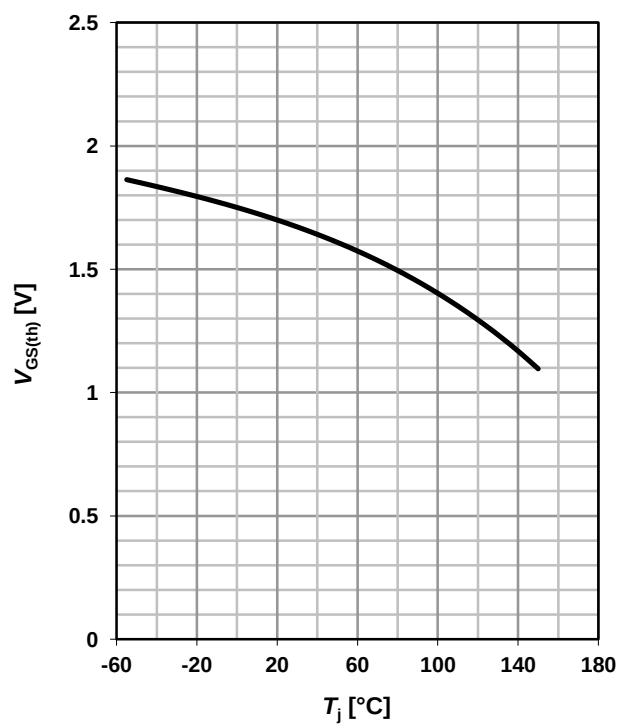

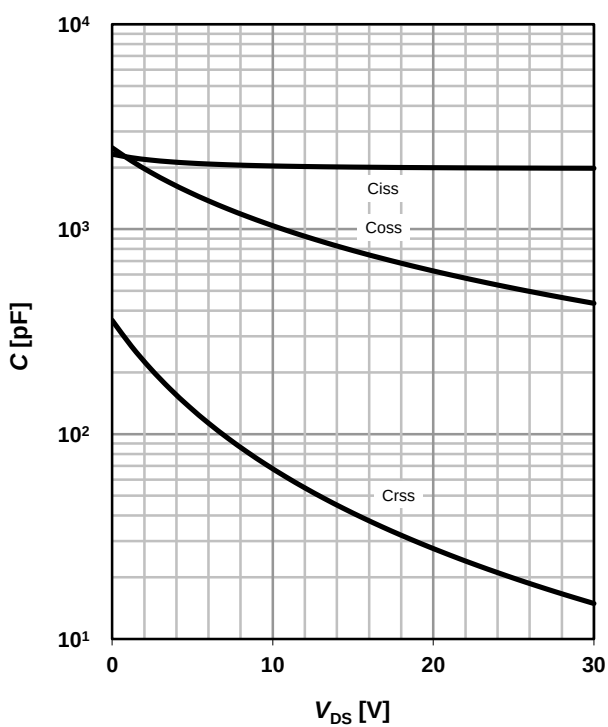

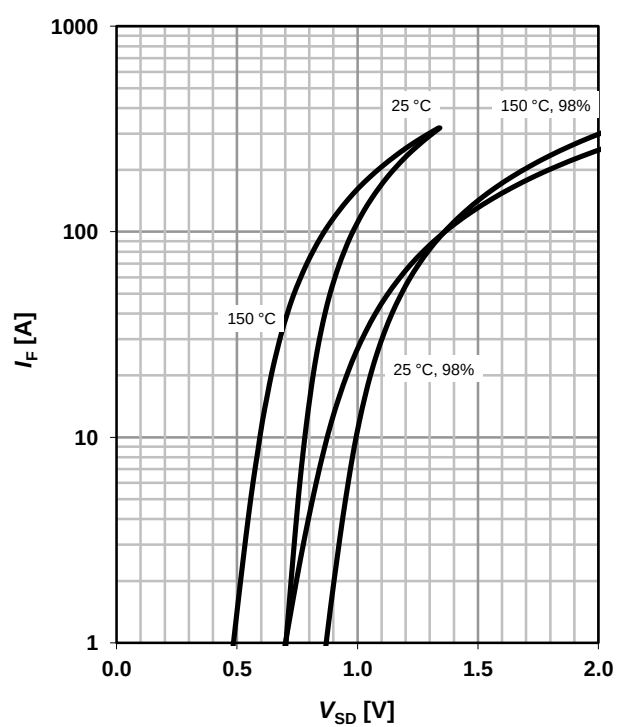

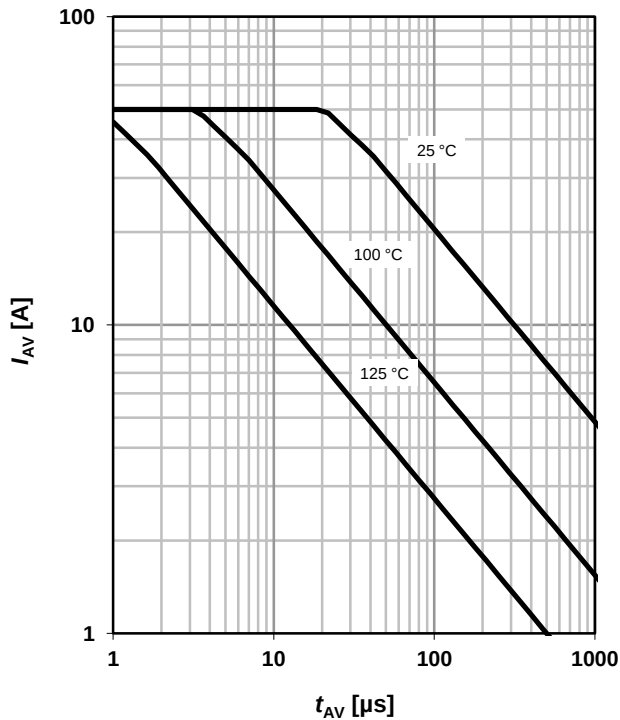

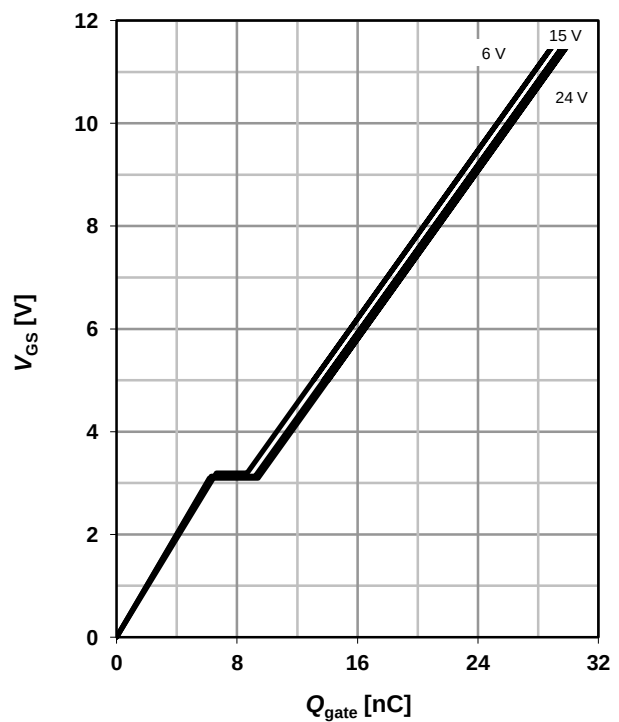

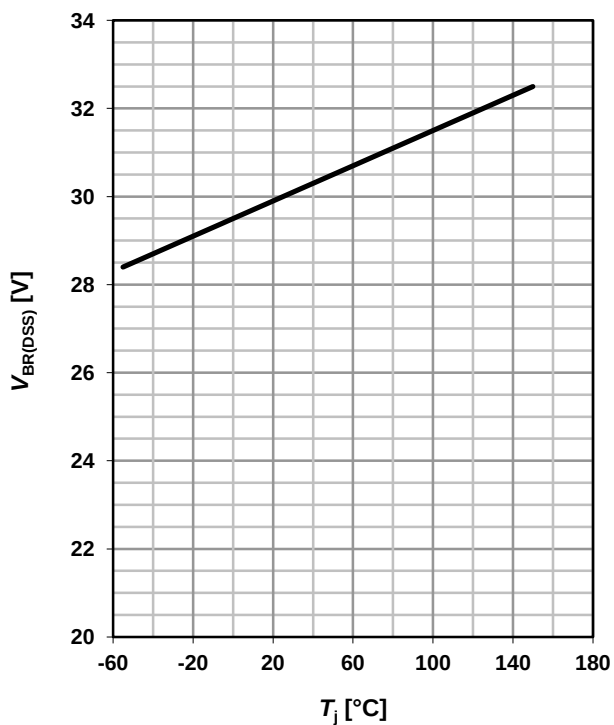

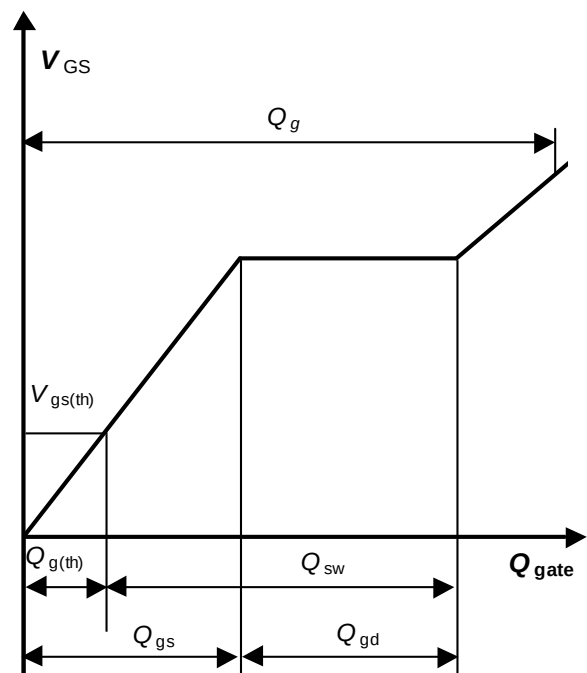

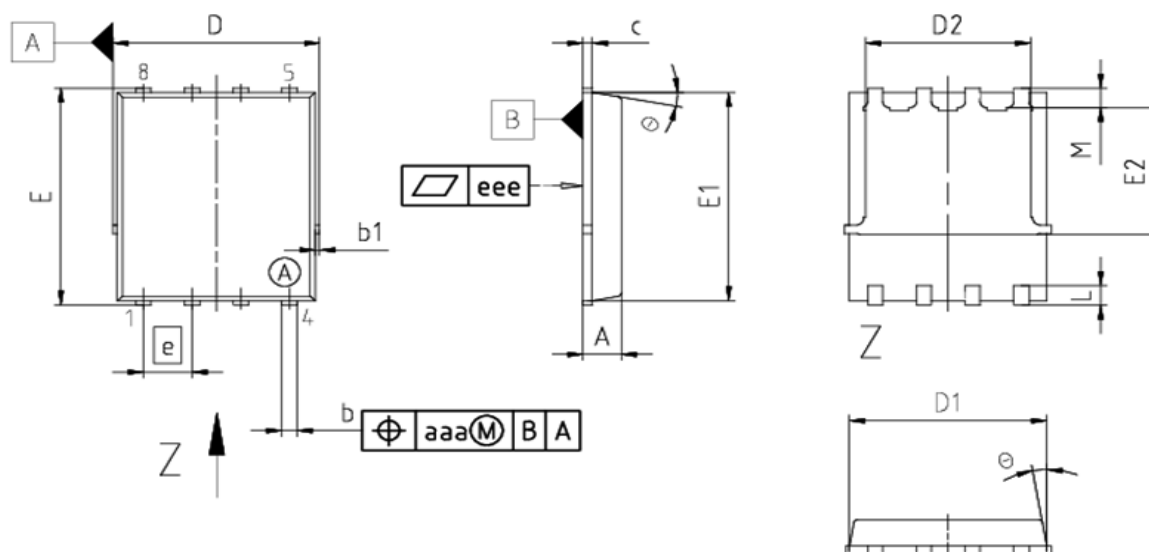
16 Gate charge waveforms



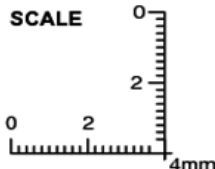
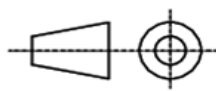
