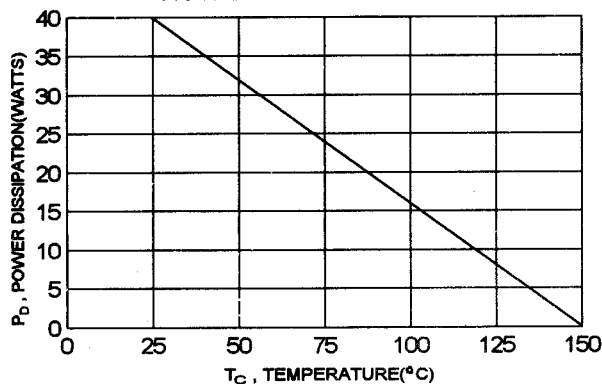

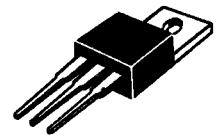

FIGURE -1 POWER DERATING

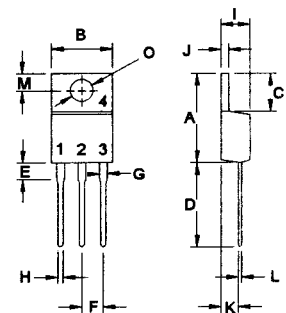

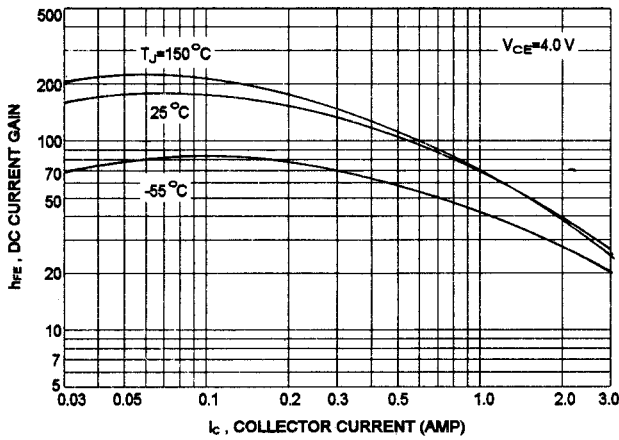

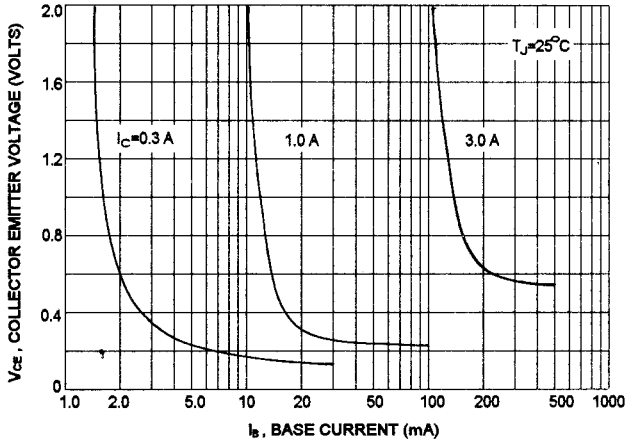

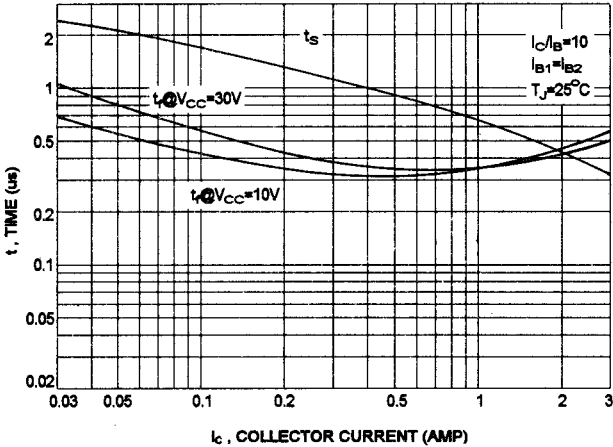
DC CURRENT GAIN



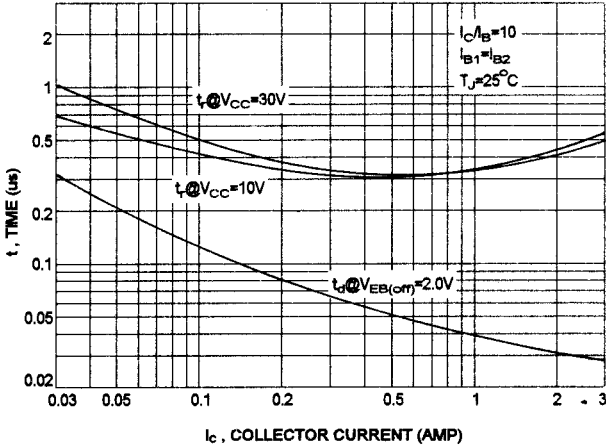
COLLECTOR SATURATION REGION



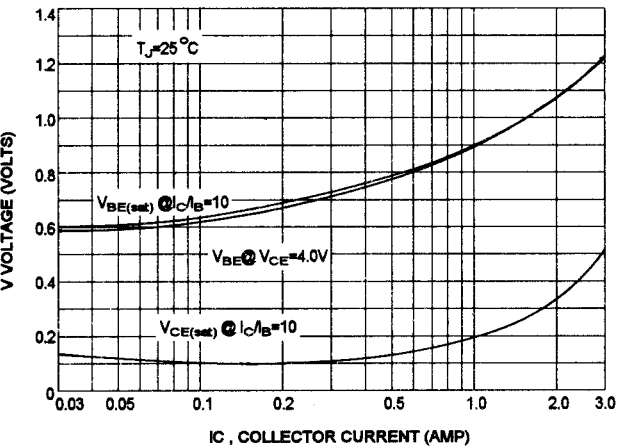
TURN-OFF TIME
