1. General description

The 74HC1G04; 74HCT1G04 is a single inverter. Inputs include clamp diodes. This enables the use of current limiting resistors to interface inputs to voltages in excess of V_{CC} .

2. Features and benefits

- Wide supply voltage range from 2.0 V to 6.0 V
- Input levels:
 - For 74HC1G04: CMOS level
 - For 74HCT1G04: TTL level
- Symmetrical output impedance
- High noise immunity
- CMOS low power dissipation
- Balanced propagation delays
- Latch-up performance exceeds 100 mA per JESD 78 Class II Level B
- Complies with JEDEC standards:
 - JESD8C (2.7 V to 3.6 V)
 - JESD7A (2.0 V to 6.0 V)
- ESD protection:
 - HBM: ANSI/ESDA/JEDEC JS-001 class 2 exceeds 2000 V
 - CDM: ANSI/ESDA/JEDEC JS-002 class C3 exceeds 1000 V
- Specified from -40 °C to +85 °C and -40 °C to +125 °C

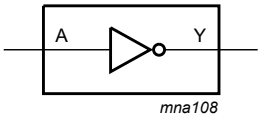


Fig. 1. Logic symbol

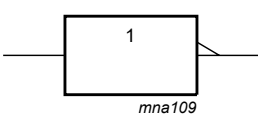


Fig. 2. IEC logic symbol

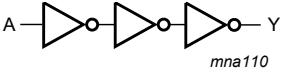
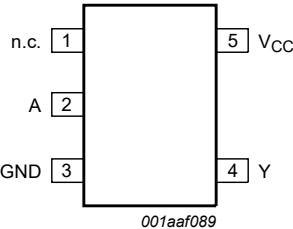


Fig. 3. Logic diagram

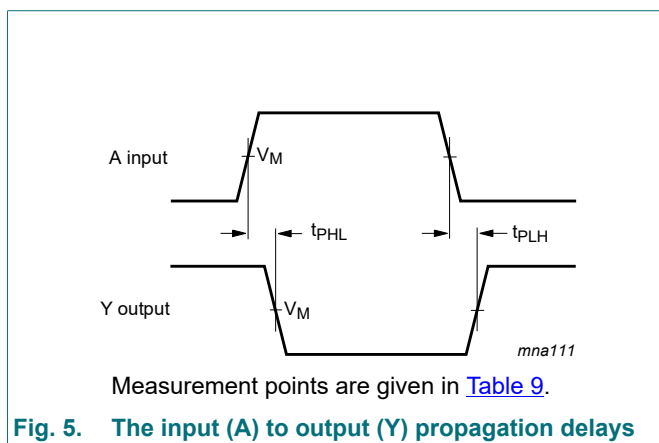
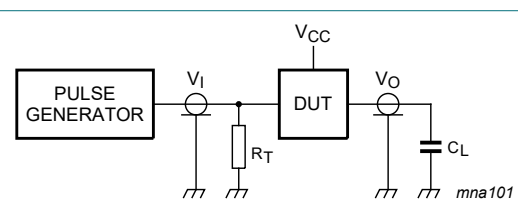

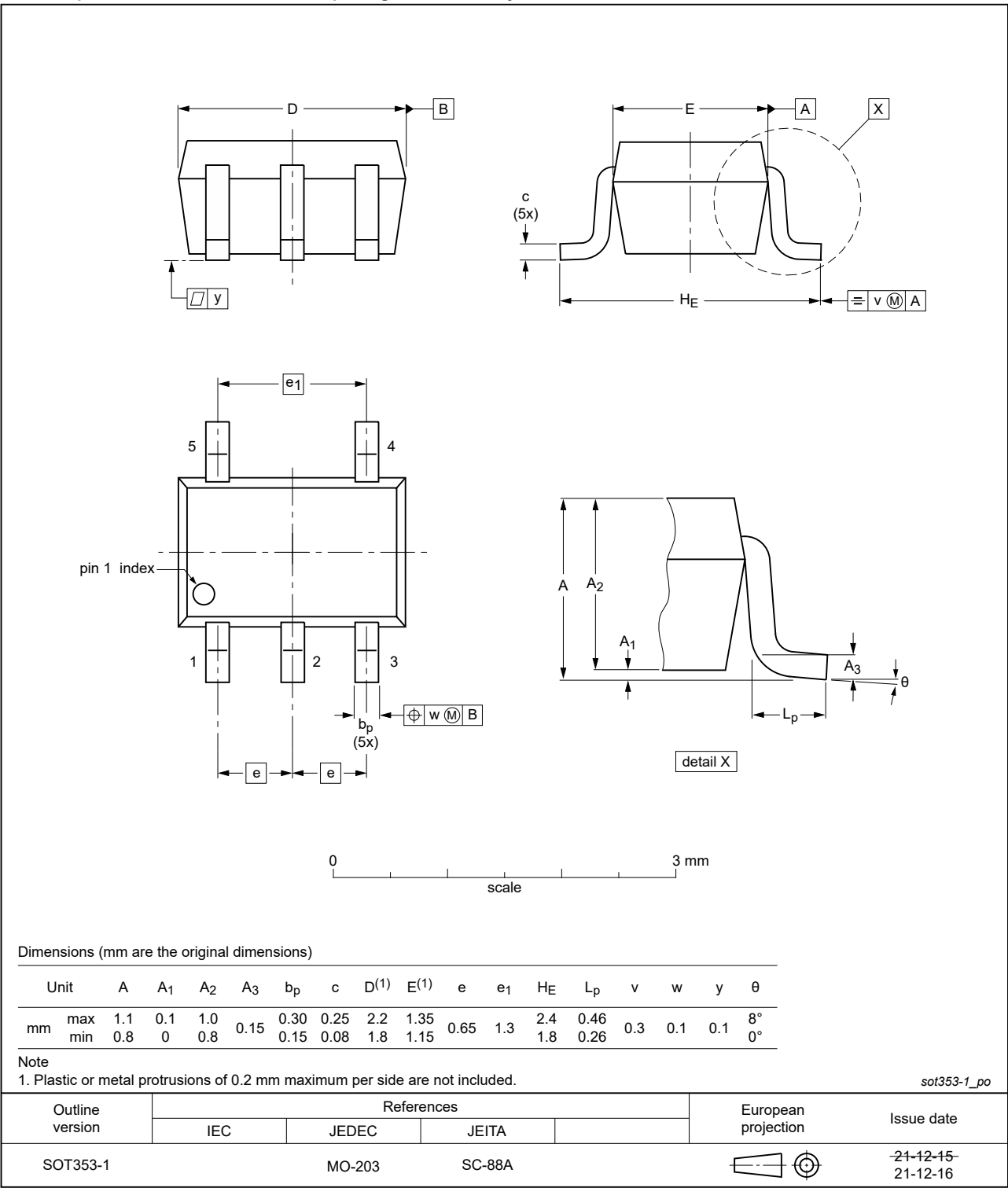


Fig. 7. Package outline SOT353-1 (TSSOP5)

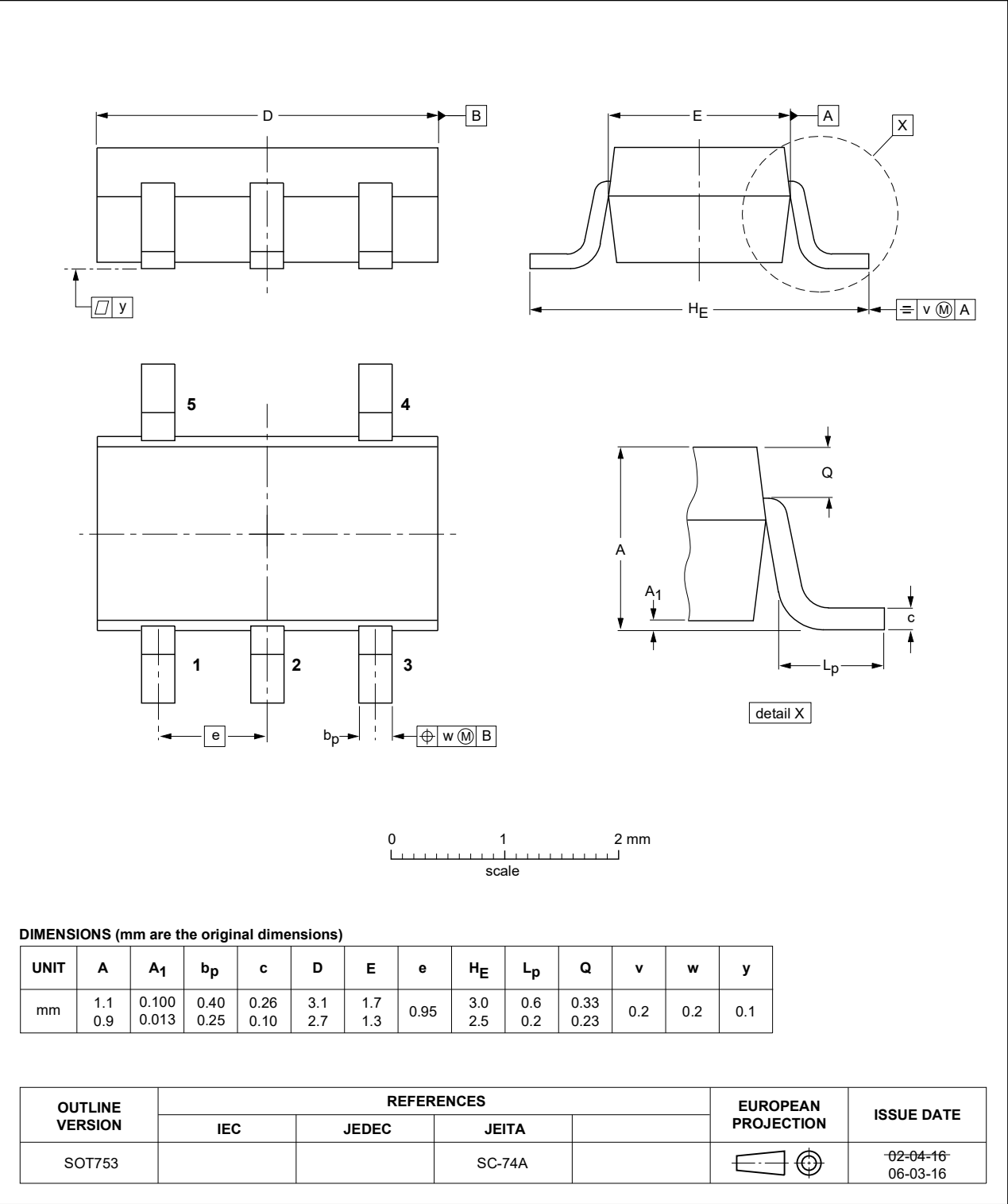


Fig. 8. Package outline SOT753 (SC-74A)
