Planar Schottky barrier rectifier with an integrated guard ring for stress protection, encapsulated in a small and flat lead SOD323F (SC-90) Surface-Mounted Device (SMD) plastic package.

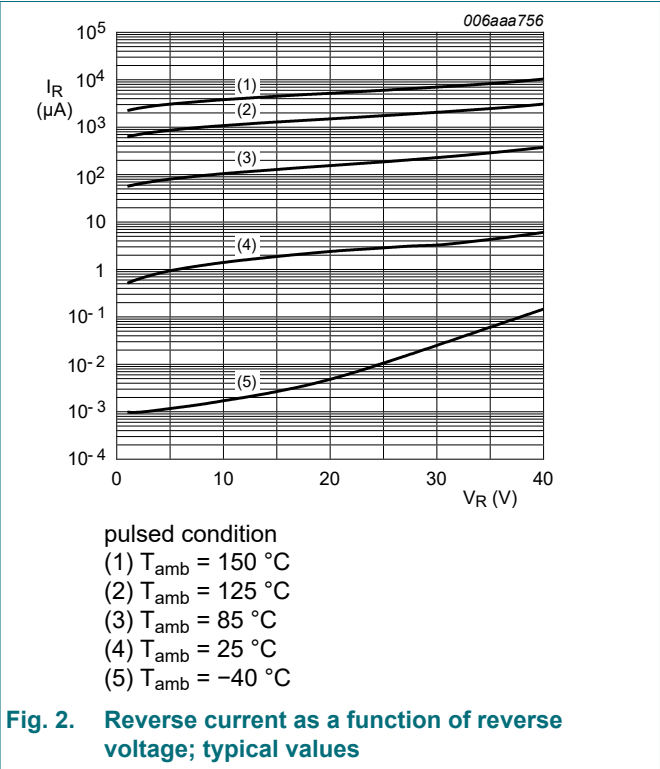

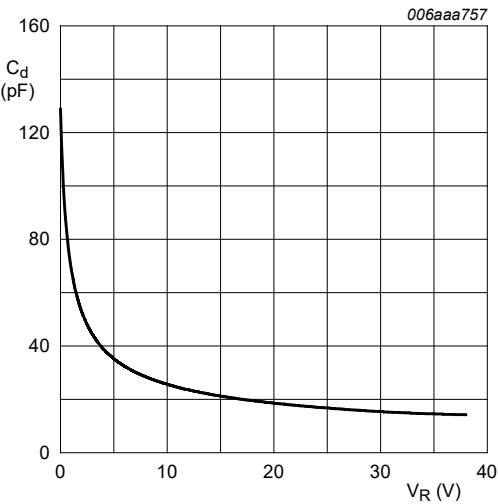

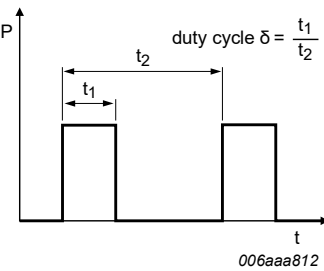


Fig. 4. Duty cycle definition

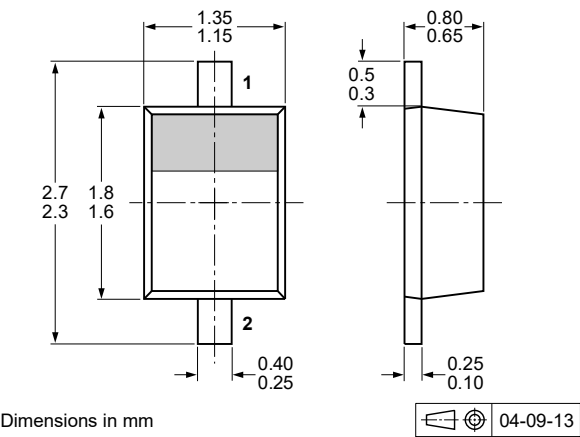
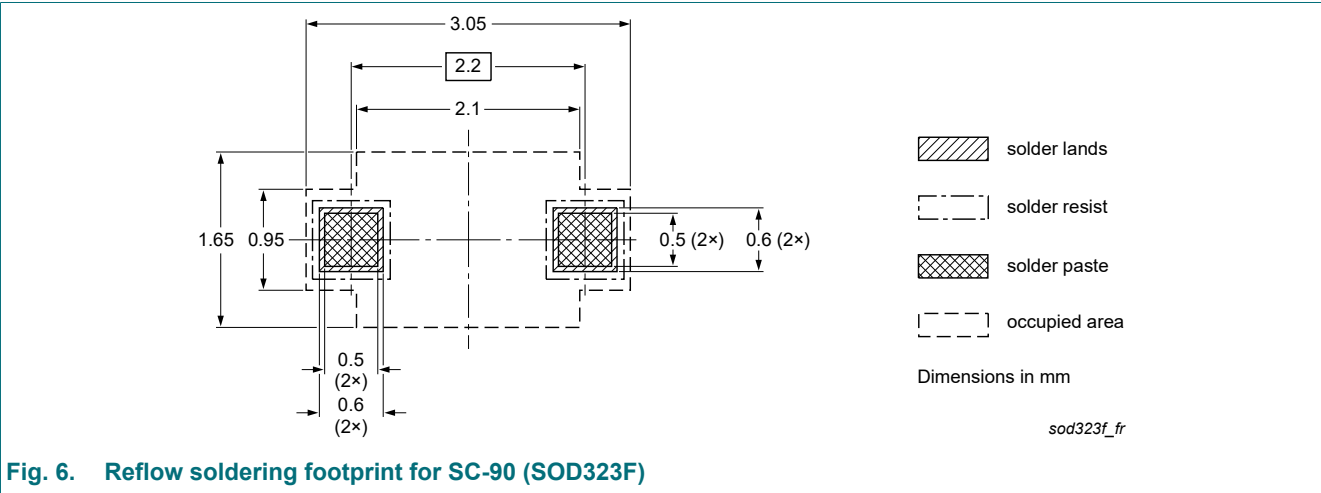


Fig. 5. Package outline SC-90 (SOD323F)
